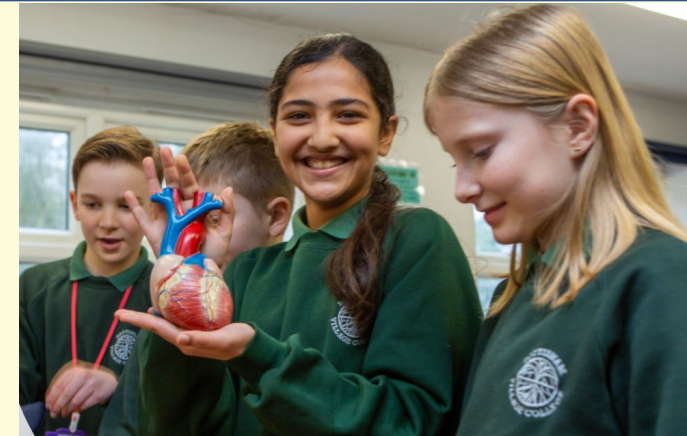

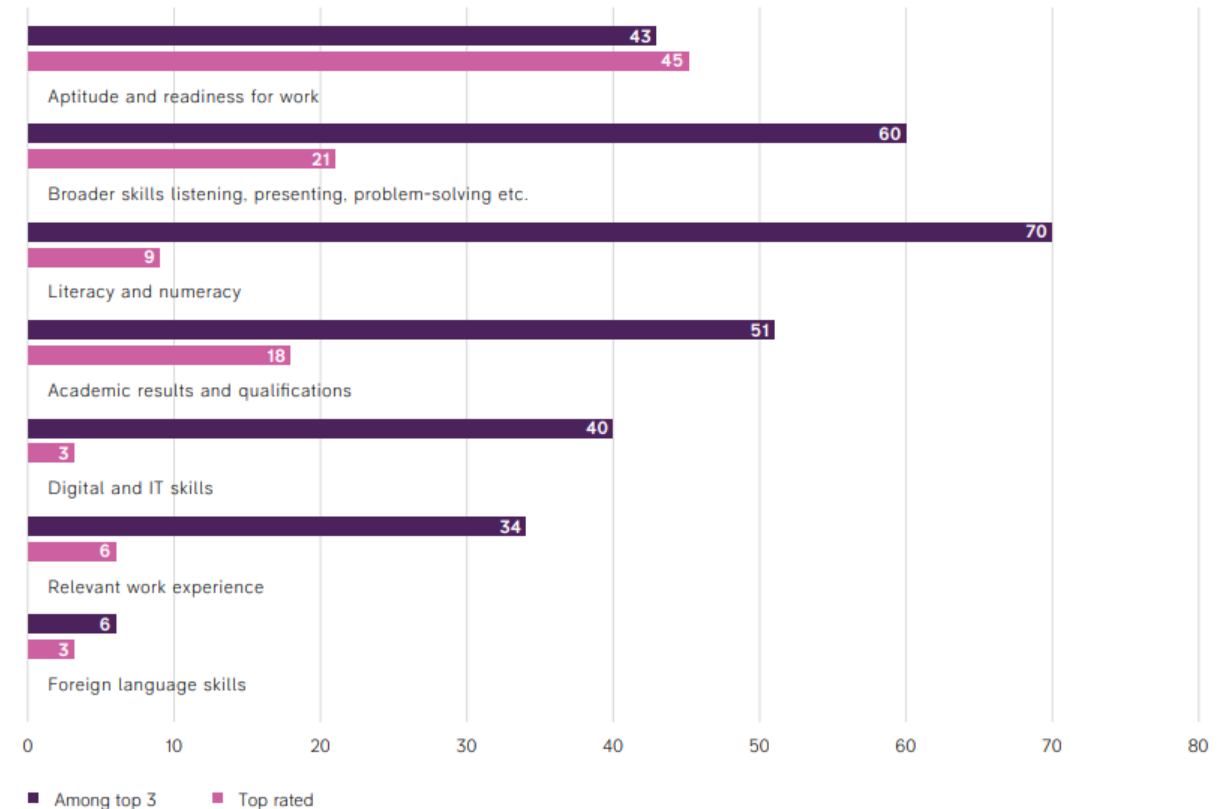

Exhibit 1 Most important factors in recruiting school/college leavers (%)

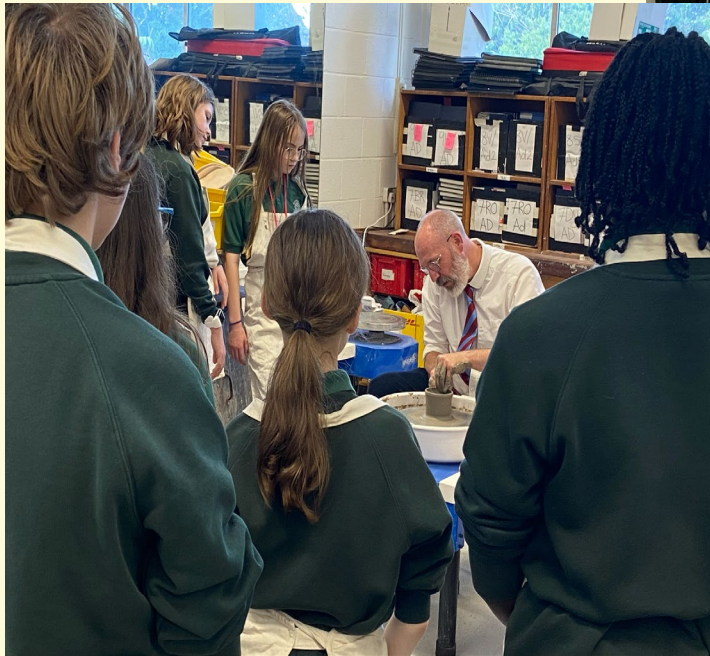

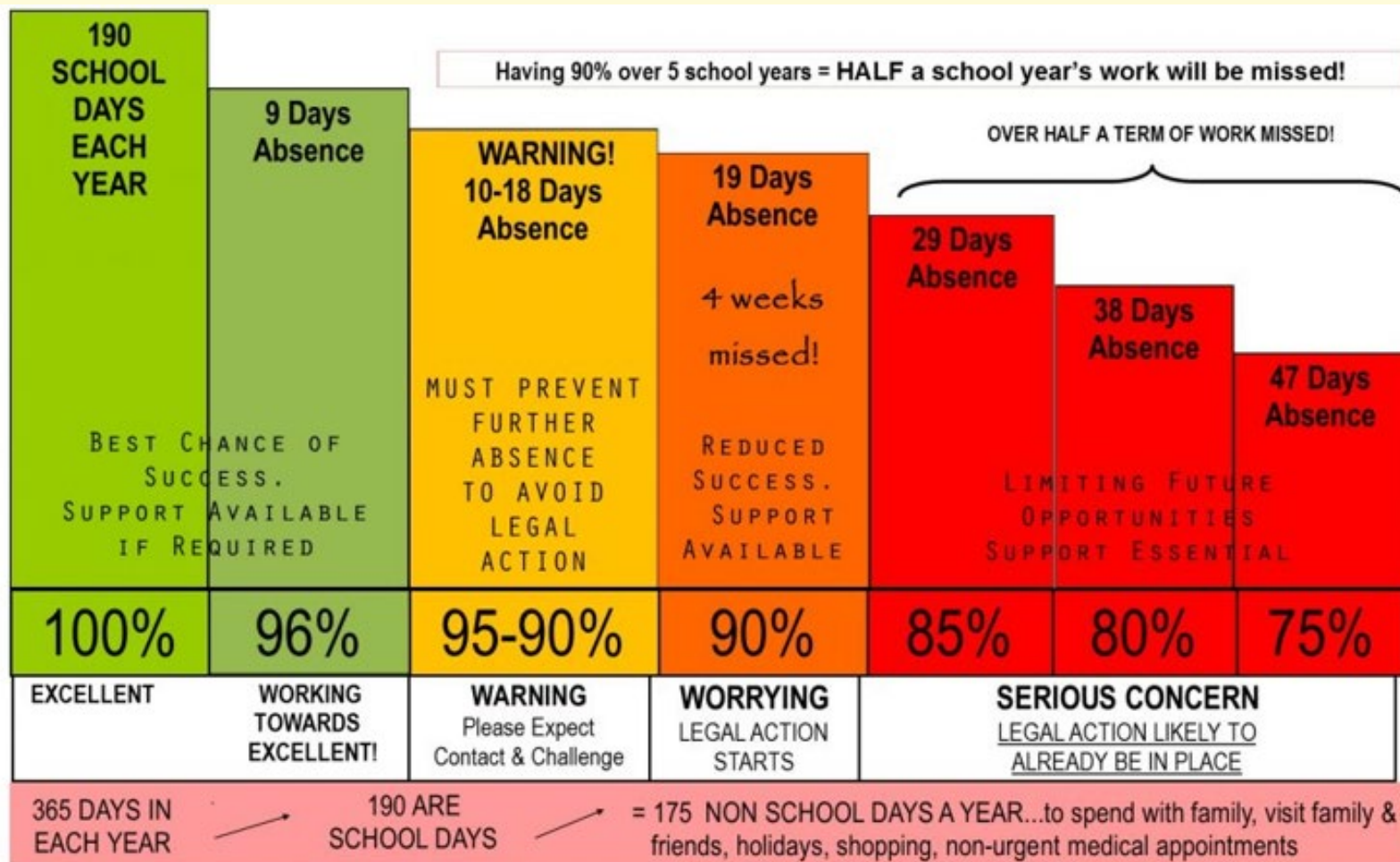

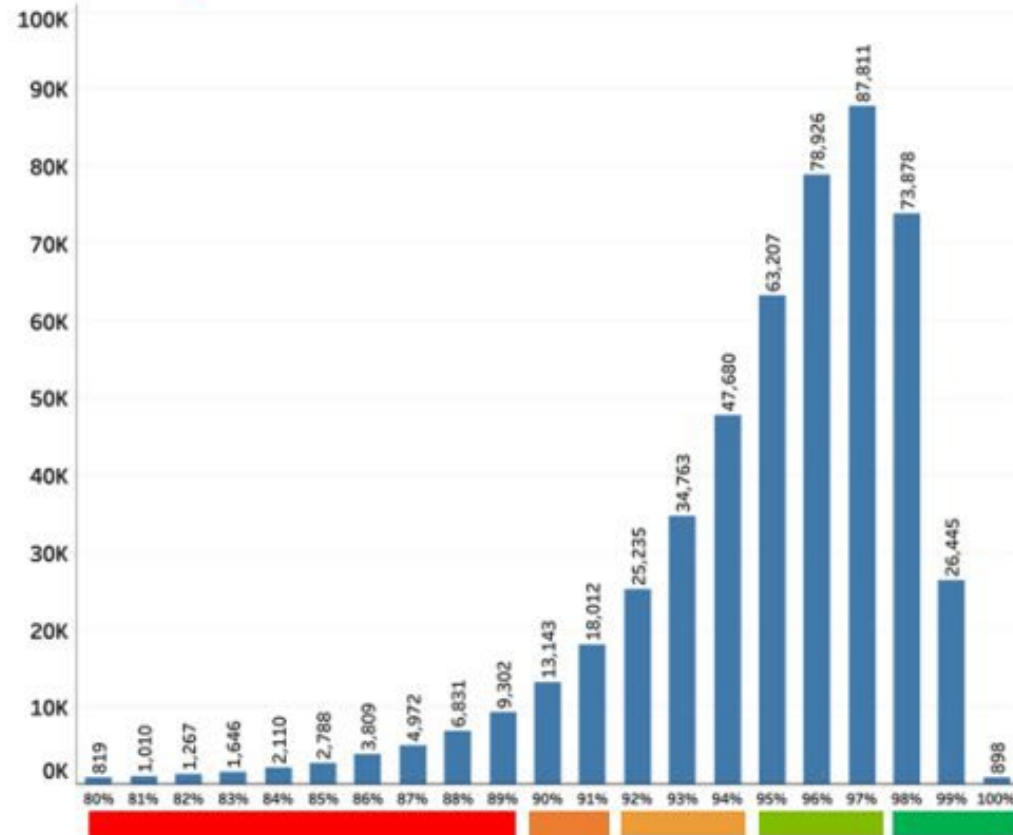

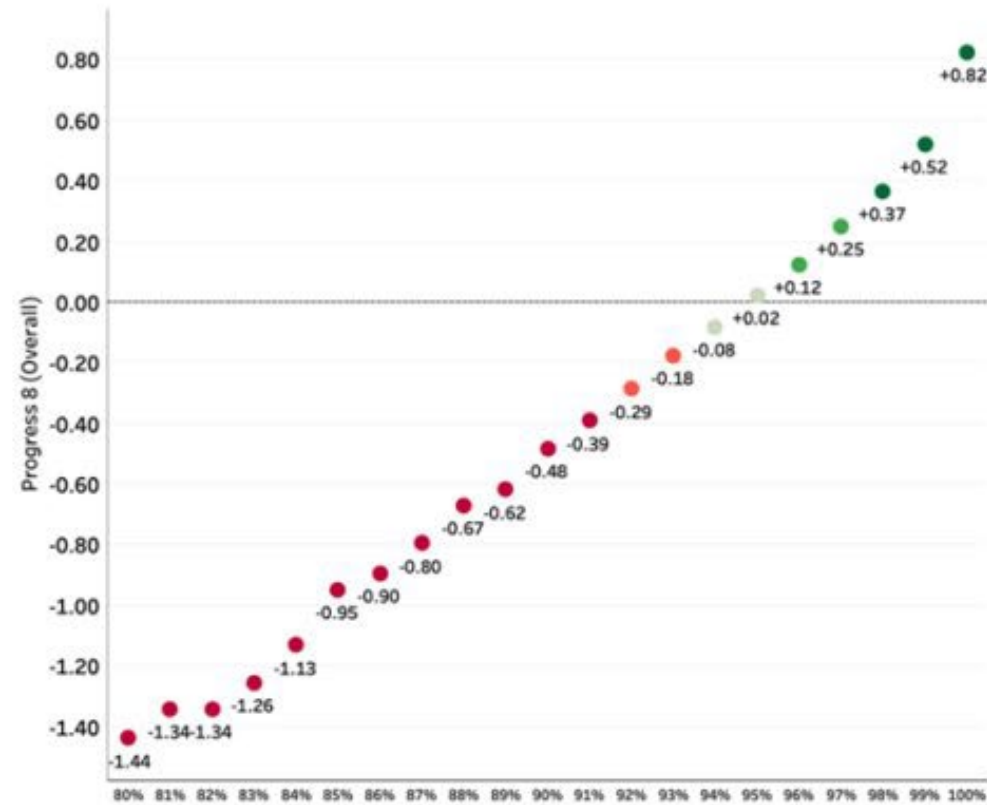




Why is attendance so important?

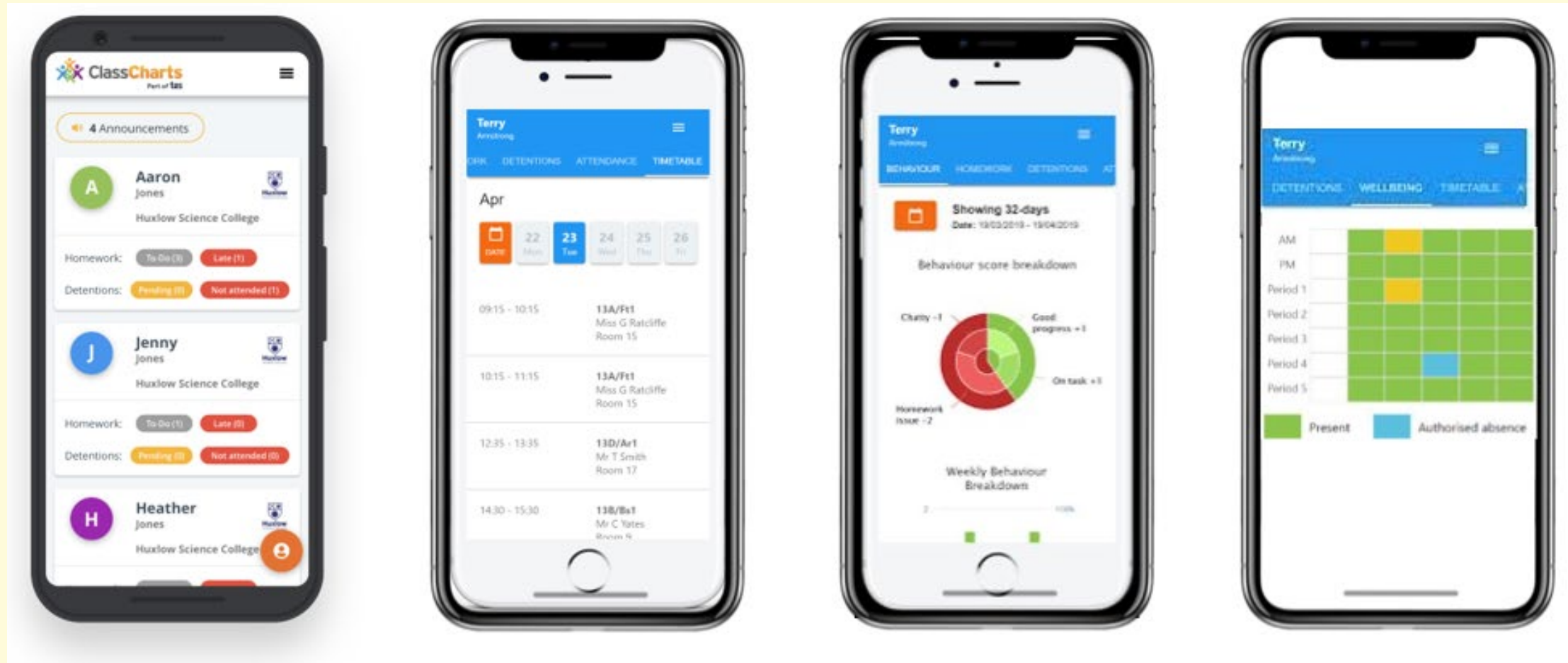
