I am writing to invite your child to Year 7 Camp.

Bottisham Village College has been running their Year 7 Camp for many years; it has become one of the highlights of an education at Bottisham. Students have the opportunity to be away from home in a friendly and safe environment. There are lots of new activities to try, and the chance for new relationships to form. Such is the popularity of the camp that many of the leaving Year 11s are desperate to return as leaders to support the new Year 7 cohort.

Eaton Vale Adventure Centre

We are based at the Eaton Vale Adventure Centre in Norwich with full toilet and shower facilities, as well as indoor spaces should the weather be against us. The Centre offers a wide range of adventure activities including climbing, canoeing, archery, abseiling, and is licensed through the Adventure Activities Licensing Authority. Qualified staff lead these activities and detailed risk assessments have been completed by the school. In addition to the Centre lead activities, there are a number of sessions designed to build personal confidence and social skills, led by Bottisham staff.

Sleeping Arrangements

The core experience of the camp is spending the night under canvas. This is mostly done in friendship groups of 4-6 in large dome type tents. Most never forget the comradeship of working together, assisted by their Year 11 leader. The sleeping areas are secure and arranged in small, supervised areas.

Dates and Costs

The camp runs from Monday 10 July to Friday 14 July 2023

The cost per student is **£167.00**, which includes:

- ✓ All transport from BVC to Norwich and return
- ✓ Tent accommodation for 4 nights
- ✓ All meals including snacks, drinks and fruit BUT no sweets!
- ✓ At least five activities a day and instruction-20 activity rotation
- ✓ Evening campfires, songs and daily awards
- ✓ Lots of laughter guaranteed

- An initial non-refundable deposit of £44.00 is payable by Friday 24 February 2023
- A second non-refundable payment of £41.00 is payable by Friday 31 March 2023
- A third non-refundable payment of £41.00 will be payable by Sunday 30 April 2023
- A final payment of £41.00 will be payable by Wednesday 31 May 2023

All you have to do now is pay the initial non-refundable deposit of **£44.00** on WisePay by **Friday 24 February 2023**.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals and/or pupil premium entitlements you are entitled to some financial assistance. Please note it is important that you request the financial assistance by this due date as it may not be available at a later date.
