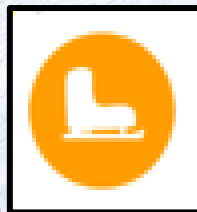
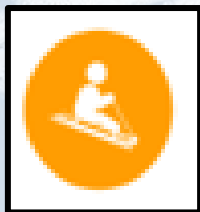

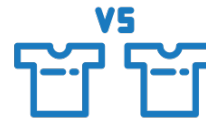

Packing

Ski Trip kit list

Only 1 bag per person is allowed. Please pack using a soft bag NOT a hard case (Coach has limited storage!)

Your ski jacket will be your coat for this trip – another coat will not be required.

Essential kit required for skiing:

- Hat/head warmer (that fits under ski helmet – no bobble)
- Ski socks x 3 min.
- Under Jacket Layers x2 min (lots of small layers are better than 1 thick layer)
- Waterproof Ski Jacket
- Waterproof Ski Trousers/Salopettes
- Waterproof Ski Gloves/Mittens
- Ski Goggles
- Leg thermal/leggings
- Factor 50+ Face Sun Cream (ESSENTIAL!)
- Lip Balm with sun protection
- Face scarf/balaclava
- Spending Money for meal on journey to and from resort (please note minimal spending money will be required during the trip as most aspects are already paid for)

Optional (but recommended) kit for skiing:

- Sunglasses
- Hand/foot warmers

Packing

Essential non-skiing luggage:

- Passport – with a **minimum of 6 months** remaining from our return date (April 6, 2023)
- EHIC card – Valid and in-date
- Snow boots/Waterproof boots
- Trousers x2
- Tee shirts x 6
- Underwear x 9
- Ski trip hoodie (will be provided by the school)
- Socks
- Pyjamas
- Bath towel
- Cosmetics (shower gel, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, hairbrush)
- Food and drink for coach journey

Optional (but recommended) non-skiing luggage:

- Camera
- Mobile phone
- Trainers
- Coach entertainment (Magazines, Book, Music, headphones, cards)
- **Small** travel pillow (for coach journey)
- Small bag for coach journey
- **Small amount** of Euros for journey to and from Italy, and free time in the village of Bormio

Skiing

- ❖ Kit checks daily before leaving hotel
- ❖ 5 hours of ski lessons per day
 - 9-12pm
 - 1-3pm
- ❖ In ski ability groups lead by Italian qualified instructors (max 12 pupils per group)

Wear lots of sun cream!

Mobile Phones

Our policy to safeguard all students is that phones will only be allowed to be used in the dining hall. They will be collected in by staff each evening before bed and safely stored.

Emergency parent contact

A medical form will be sent out after Christmas – permission for any medications is required – including paracetamol!

Code of conduct

There will be a code of conduct sent out after Christmas. This is ensure all parents and students are aware of our expectations on the trip, and what sanctions will be put in place whilst in Italy if necessary.
