I am writing to inform you about the Duke of Edinburgh Award, which we launched before half-term with year 9.

This long-established award represents a fantastic opportunity for young people to develop skills and gain experiences that develop them as people. These skills and experiences are valued by post-16 centres, universities, and employers. Students who take part in the award show that they have a commitment to serving the communities in which they live and work.

The award is split into four parts; three service elements, which students must complete independently, and an expedition section, which is completed as part of a team. The service elements are categorised into three areas: Volunteering, Skill, and Physical activities; two of these sections need to be completed for three months and the other section for six months. It will be up to the student to choose which activities and timeframes they commit to for each section.

As part of the Bronze DofE Award, students are also required to attend training weekends as well as an assessed expedition on the following dates:

- Account set up session: 29 November 2023
- Training in school: 14 May 2024, 23 May 2024, 20 June 2024
- Expedition training weekend: 8-9 June 2024- Devil's Dyke
- Expedition assessed weekend: 11-12 July 2024 Biggleswade Scout Group **Campsite**

The cost of participating in the Bronze DofE award will be approximately £100 subject to the number of participants, subject to change, and can be paid in the following instalments:

- Initial non-refundable enrolment fee of £25.50 payable by Monday 20 November 2023
- Second payment of £25.00 payable by Monday 1 January 2024
- Third payment of £25.00 payable by Thursday 1 February 2024
- Final balance (estimated to be £24.50) payable by Friday 1 March 2024

Please note, to be accepted onto the expedition weekend, full payment and online submission of eDofE Program Plans must be completed. This deadline will be communicated nearer the time.

The deposit and the enrolment form should be paid and returned as soon as possible, with a deadline of 20 November 2024 to ensure your child's place on the Bronze DofE Award programme.
