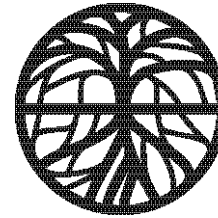

<p>Curriculum Delivery Key Stage 4</p>	<p>Students have 3 lessons a fortnight.</p> <p>Unit R033- This is assessed by completing coursework tasks in year 10. Unit R034- This is assessed by completing coursework tasks across year 10 and 11. Unit R032- This is assessed in a written exam in May/June of year 11.</p>		
<p>Curriculum aims Years 10 & 11</p>	<p>The Health and Social Care curriculum aims to give students an understanding of how someone develops throughout their life, considering the different factors that affect their development. It explores some of the key fundamentals to supporting an individual in society and in a health and social care setting.</p> <p>Students gain an understanding of how different events in life can affect an individual during different stages of their life and how they can be supported through this.</p> <p>The curriculum aims to build on their extended writing, knowledge and problem solving as well as developing an empathy and understanding for life and the way it can affect someone.</p>
