Year 11 Timeline

Add GCSE exam period dates to your calendar. Note dates when Year 11 students are due in school.	ASAP

At this time of year, we finalise the year 11 timeline so that students and their families can best prepare. The formal examination season runs from 6 May to 24 June: it is a busy few weeks, with a half-term break taking place W/B 27 May. As a result, we have orchestrated a timeline which we hope will benefit students at an important time in their education.

Phase 1: 6 May – 23 May

Students will be in school either sitting their exams or in their timetabled curriculum sessions.

Phase 2: Celebration Day on 24 May

As usual, we shall have this celebratory day in the usual fashion. Students sitting the French exam on this day will join the festivities afterwards: details to follow.

Phase 3: 3 June – 12 June

Students shall be in school doing the following:

- **Sitting exams**
- **Attending timetabled lessons**
- **Attending re-timetabled revision sessions**

We shall be looking at adapting our timetable to ensure that students are prepared for some of the exams which take place during this phase.

Phase 4: June 12 - June 19

Students attend exams as normal and leave immediately afterwards or remain on site in a provision which shall be organised: details to follow.

Phase 5: June 26

This is the examination contingency day, the last day on which students must be available to sit examinations.

Phase 6: Leavers' Ball 28 June and Results Day 22 August

These are the final two dates in the timeline.
