### **Bishop Laney Sixth Form**

Students holding offers with Bishop Laney should upload their results and confirm their place via our online process, the link to which will be provided to Offer Holders in July. Anyone with queries may call 01353 652818 on Results Day once they have their results to discuss their place between 9:30am and 2:30pm. Those whose results mean they need a further discussion will be invited to book a guidance meeting appointment later on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August or Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> August in the morning. The majority of which will be online, though on-site appointments will also be available. Students who wish to discuss a late application or to reinstate an offer, should contact 01353 652818 on Thursday, or between 10am and 2pm on Friday. ## College of West Anglia

All applicants will be expected to upload a photo of their grade sheet to our student portal. This will allow us to confirm that the applicant has met the entry requirements for their course and complete their enrolment.

If an applicant doesn't meet the entry requirements for the course, we will contact them to discuss their options. ## Hills Road Sixth Form College

In July, offer holders will receive an email with guidance on the Hills Road enrolment process, including **how to submit their exam results via the enrolment platform on Thursday, 22 August (GCSE Results Day)**.

Please do not contact Admissions about how to enrol before receiving the email in July. Please also be aware that course change requests are part of enrolment and cannot be processed beforehand.

**For most offer holders, enrolment will take place online.** Students will be required to complete a two-stage process:

- **Stage One:** Download a document, scan or photograph of the GCSE exam results given or sent to them by their current school, and their photograph (following the guidelines of how to take this on a phone).
- **Stage Two:** Once the College has reviewed the exam results and checked the photograph, offer holders will receive an email to explain how to complete Stage Two enrolment.

If an offer holder's GCSE results do not meet the entry requirements for their chosen A level course/s, the College will email them on **Friday, 23 August** with an appointment to attend enrolment in person at Hills Road on **Tuesday, 27 August**. During this meeting, one of the College's A level specialists will discuss whether a place can be offered and in which subjects.

Offer holders are advised to **keep Tuesday 27 August available**, in case we need to discuss their course.

### Impington International College

All students holding offers will need to upload their results by **1pm on 22<sup>nd</sup> August, via MyChoice or Applicaa**. There will be an opportunity for students who do not meet their offer to discuss their situation with one of our Heads of Sixth Form on the 23<sup>rd</sup> August. **All applicants will be sent information well in advance of GCSE results day outlining the enrolment process in detail.**

### Long Road Sixth Form College

All students who hold an offer with us will be sent an overview of the enrolment process in July, including how and when to submit their exam results.

**Exam results will need to be submitted via Admissions+ by no later than 1pm on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> August.** Students can expect to receive offers from 23<sup>rd</sup> August, onwards. Students will be given the opportunity to request an enrolment meeting (conducted via telephone) to discuss their course options. Those who **do not meet the entry requirements for their original choices, will automatically be invited to a telephone meeting** to discuss alternative courses that they *are* qualified to study, *wherever possible*. Meetings will be scheduled across the 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> August, therefore we ask students to make themselves available for those dates.

Once the enrolment offer has been accepted, students will receive IT onboarding instructions to be completed online, ahead of orientation.

### **Northstowe Sixth Form**

Students holding offers with Northstowe Sixth Form will be sent information regarding enrolment by the end of term.

We would encourage students to enrol in person once GCSE results have been received so we can answer any questions you may have or discuss your subject choices if needed.

For all students who wish to accept their NSF offer, there will be a Microsoft Form to fill in prior to enrolling.

For Northstowe Secondary College Year 11 students, this can take place immediately once results have been received.

For students from other schools, enrolment will take place on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 1pm to 4pm and Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 9am to 1pm.

The Sixth Form Team will be on site to help and answer any questions hence encouraging enrolling in person.

Students will need to bring copies of their GCSE results (or equivalent) with them to enrolment, plus a copy of a passport or equivalent documentation as proof of identity.

Students who have not met their offer entry requirements are also encouraged to attend in person to discuss their options.

Once you have completed the Enrolment process, we will update your online admissions portal with details of your next step. We will send you details of your Induction session.

### **West Suffolk College**
